As a part of their social project, students of Grade JCL2 visited ABWA, to address their students, to promote the Stationery Collection Drive.



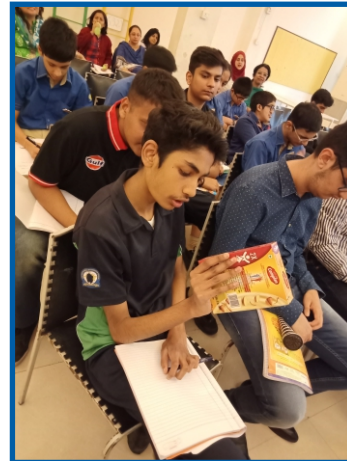
